16km race in Negri Sembilan forest reserve includes nature-inspired games and trivia

MEMBERS of Pertubuhan Pelindung Khazanah Alam Malaysia (PEKA) will be organising an adventure-style race known as "Save the Rainforest Race (SORR) 2016" in March.

Held in conjunction with the success of their race held since 2013, SORR has since been held annually, and 2016 promises nothing less than a fruitful and educational time of learning the importance of conserving the environment, especially within the forests of Malaysia.

SORR 2016 will be held on March 26, . at the Centre for Eco-Tourism Education Edutourism in Sungai Menyala Forest Reserve, Port Dickson, Negri Sembilan. The race is aimed at raising awareness on the rapidly decreasing forests in the country and taking care of the forests in Malaysia through sustainable measures.

Participants will go through a 16km race which involves a series of activities including nature-inspired games and trivia related to the SORR 2016 theme.

Each team will consist of two people. The programme also aims at raising funds in aid of awareness campaigns and educational programmes in future.

About 2,000 participants are expected to take part in SORR 2016.
