# Experience 'Yanxi Palace' at Seremban

## Get a first-hand look at a replica of the set of the hit TV drama this festive season

**SEREMBAN:** The entrance to the d'Tempat Country Club in Bandar Sri Sendayan near here now resembles a set from *Story of Yanxi Palace*, a Chinese period drama which premiered last year and became a huge hit in Asia.

Those who wish to have a first-hand look at the architecture of the Qing Dynasty and the decorations put up during Chinese New Year are welcome to visit the premises as Malaysians usher in the Year of the Pig.

They will be able to view a replica of a set from *Yanxi Palace* – named the world's most Googled TV show in 2018 – from 10am to 10pm daily till March 3.

Developer and club owner Matrix Concepts Holdings Bhd chief marketing officer Lim Kok Yee said the company decided to create the set to allow visitors to have a feel of *Yanxi Palace*.

"Since the d'Tempat Country Club is the most happening club in town, we decided to again showcase the best Chinese New Year to local folks as well as to visitors.

"This is also important as Chinese New Year has always been a joyous time for all Malaysians and that we should continue to live in harmony and strengthen our ties regardless of ethnicity, culture and religion," he said.

He said several activities had been lined up to celebrate the Year of the Pig, with the main ones taking place on Feb 16 and 17.

The highlight will be on Feb 16 when the famous Hong Kong comic character Old



Master Q, his buddy Mr Potato and Mr Chin will act in a play called *Old Master Q Lost in Yanxi Palace*.

"There will also be a performance of eight lion dances followed by acrobatic lion dances to shower blessing and good fortune to all our guests," he said, adding that there would also be a traditional Chinese umbrella dance, mask-changing show and multi-racial dance performances.

There will be other activities such as sand art, hand fan painting and Chinese calligraphy, and an appearance by the God of Prosperity.

To mark the occasion, a photography contest for both professionals and non-professionals would also be held to capture the best scenes at Bandar Sri Sendayan.

They can submit as many entries as they wish from Feb 1 to 28.

The winner will receive RM3,888 while the first runner-up will receive RM2,888 and second runner-up will receive RM1,888.

There will also be 10 consolation prizes worth RM388 each.
