Matrix Concepts donates RM3 million

PETALING JAYA: Tabung Harapan Malaysia has amassed over RM35 million in donations from the public in just six days since it was established.

As of press time yesterday, the fund has

collected RM35,772,017.10.

Yesterday, Matrix Concepts Holdings Berhad chief executive Datuk Lee Tian Hock donated RM3 million on behalf of the company to Finance Minister Lim Guan Eng

at his office in Putrajaya.

The fund was set up by the Pakatan Harapan government on May 30 to accept contributions from the public to help ease the nation's RM1 trillion debt.
