

NEGRI MB LAUNCHES SENDAYAN PROJECT

60 single-storey houses with RM7m govt subsidy available, says Mohamad

MENTERI Besar Datuk Seri Mohamad Hasan fulfilled promises made a year ago when he launched the Sendayan Second Generation Housing Project in Taman Bukit Sendayan yesterday.

He said 60 single-storey terrace houses were available to eligible buyers with a government subsidy of RM7 million.

"The three-bedroom houses were built for the second- and third-generation Sendayan residents, who are married, with a household income of RM3,000 and had yet to own a home.

"Each unit with (built-up area of) 82 square metres will be sold at about RM80,000," he said after launching the project yesterday. The project was carried out by Matrix Concepts Holdings Berhad.

Mohamad said applicants needed to get verification from the Village's Development and Safety Committee or the mosque

that they were Sendayan-born before submitting the forms to the state government's Housing Unit.

He said the state government

would build 182 more houses at Jalan Jimah and 4,000 more in Labu.

"We wish to launch the construction of 850 housing units in Iringan Bayu, Mambau, that would be sold at RM80,000 each.

"This is a gift from the government for those who have worked hard in developing the state," he said.

He said the affordable housing project that fetched a market price of RM200,000 would be

able to settle land disputes in Sendayan since 1996.

He said the project was part of the Negri Sembilan Development Policy 2015-2045.

Present was State Secretary Datuk Seri Mat Ali Hassan.
